Coastal Debris (Art – Poster Design) KS1



Sometimes on our beach cleans, we find litter has been left there by people visiting the beach. We come across many things such as plastic drinks bottles, flip flops, food packaging from lunches, fishing lines and hooks, toys and more.



Once on the beach, these items can get washed into the sea. When they are in the ocean, this marine debris often gets mistaken for food by hungry sea creatures, causing harm to the animals that eat it. To stop this from happening, we need your help!

Design a poster which could be displayed at the beach, reminding people to put their rubbish in the bin or take it home with them.

- Include interesting facts.
- Draw some pictures to make it fun.
- Make it colourful and eye-catching.
- You could even use an acrostic poem to help get your message across.

After making your poster, why not make another poster for your school reminding everyone to put their litter in the bin, not just when they are at the beach.
